This record only outlines the main activities of *Menschen für Menschen* in Ethiopia since 1981. In line with the “integrated rural development approach” various measures in the areas of agriculture, water, education, health and income are interlinked and implemented. To carry out these measures (especially the construction of wells, tapped springs and schools) in the remote regions, 3,624 km of access roads and 18 bridges have been built since 1981.
